A: Create a Moodle Account: In order to access the test you need to create a moodle account:

1. Click on “English” Language on the top right hand corner
2. Click on “Create new account” on the top left hand corner
3. Enter detail requested and click on “create my new account”
4. Click on “continue” to confirm the new account
5. A message will be sent to you email address from the E-Learning Service
6. Click on the link to confirm your registration

D: Change of Level / Course Cancellation

It is possible to change your level within the first three weeks of the semester after talking to the respective lecturers and only if there are places free in the respective course.
