Berlin School of Economics and Law (BSEL)



The Berlin School of Economics and Law (BSEL) is one of the largest Universities of Applied Sciences in the city. It has an academic staff of 190 professors and approximately 770 lecturers, plus nearly 240 research and administrative personnel, committed to realising about 50 study programmes.

The BSEL portfolio provides a wide range of professional qualifications. The University forms an academic centre specialised in business and administration skills for the public and private sector, as well as public security, the law and engineering. The majority of programmes lead to a Bachelor or Master degree, have been quality controlled and are accredited by a German agency.

Content and structure

The bachelor's study programme has a First and a Second Section.

The First Section takes four semesters and provides you with theoretical basics. It covers studies in entrepreneurship, general business and economics, business accounting and business law as well as social sciences, statistics and business mathematics.

Of course important key skills (English, communication, self management) will be trained and professionalized.



Within the Second Section you choose one of the two specialisations »start-up« or »corporate succession« and you will be introduced to the challenges of entrepreneurship.

The practice-oriented Second Section includes day-to-day business methods within the courses and creating real business plans.

During the sixth semester you will write your bachelor thesis. You will discuss questions concerning strategic management, finance, marketing or entrepreneurship.

You will finish your studying by creating a specific business plan or business model that is related to your personal start-up. This way you are well prepared to become an entrepreneur and start into self-employment.

Programme structure

The Bachelor's study programme has a First and a Second Section. The Second Section includes a comprehensive project monitoring.

Qualification

After successfully completing the study programme, the student is awarded the academic degree of *Bachelor of Arts (B. A.)* by the Berlin School of Economics and Law. This first job-qualification degree is worth a total of 180 ECTS credit points and is internationally recognized. Corresponding to their qualification students also have the possibility to gain the academic degree of *Master of Arts (M. A.)*, e. g. at the BSEL, by then going on to pass a Master's study programme which lasts three semesters.

Fee

There are no tuition fees on this programme as it is funded through public grants. Students are required to pay a semester fee. The semester fee includes a contribution to the Studentenwerk Berlin, the student representative body as well as the enrolment and administration fee. Details: www.hwr-berlin.de

Admission and application

Conditions of admission

- General university entrance certificate (Allgemeine Hochschulreife) or specialised university entrance certificate (Fachhochschulreife) – (or alternatively, a subject-related entitlement to study in accordance with § 11 Berlin Higher Education Act – BerlHG)
- Foreign applicants: German language examination for university admission

Admission procedure

Selection is based on certain requirements. You are kindly asked to have a look at www.hwr-berlin.de.

Application period (winter term)

- For applicants with a German school leaving certificate: from 1 June – 15 July
- For applicants with a non-German school leaving certificate: 15 June

Application period (summer term)

- For applicants with a German school leaving certificate: from 1 December – 15 January
- For applicants with a non-German school leaving certificate: 15 December
