Required Preconditions:
Advanced Financial Accounting

Learning Outcomes and Competencies, Subject related / Generic:
The students who already acquired very detailed knowledge about IFRS in the first semester are to prepare and to present a term paper on a special subject. In each tutorial one topic will be presented by students. Afterwards the group will discuss the outcomings and work on a case study. The combined examination consists of the written term paper plus a presentation. Students will obtain broad theoretical and practical knowledge and the capacity to discuss main accounting problems and their solutions. This course will prepare the students for the requirements of the Master thesis in the third semester.

Content of Course:
The focus of the seminar will change every year (e.g. selected components of financial statements, application of IFRS, group accounting issues, analysis of financial statements)
