Why a release of the programme?

- High degree of interfaces between the two programmes (partly similar courses taught)
- Students face difficulties when having to choose between the programmes
- Combination of two programmes offers a bigger variety of courses
- New developments (e.g. digitization, governance, sustainability) needed to get incorporated into the modules



What is new?

- FACT (new) offers a variety of modules
- Differentiation according to pre-knowledge and individual preferences is possible
- Students may choose
 - to acquire broad knowledge
 - to focus on selected aspects
- Programme offers new courses in Digitization, Corporate valuation and Sustainability studies
- Programme can be studied entirely in English, some courses taught in German



What is new?


The four core disciplines of the master's programme are flanked by a variety of courses on:

- Business law
- ERP systems
- Quantitative methods
- Business Communication



Programme Requirements:

- Modules get categorized into the four aspects F,A,C,T



students have to choose at least one module from each of the four

- Students, without experience in writing a Bachelor-Thesis attend Tutorial Seminar „academic writing“ and have to choose the „Seminar on FACT-Issues“ class
- Some courses in the 2nd semester require specialized knowledge
- Classes subject to availability, maximum of 40 participants



Admission Requirements:


- University degree (min. 180 ECTS)
- Proof that at least two of the four relevant study subjects – Accounting, Controlling, Finance and Taxation – were concluded in the previous course of studies (at least 20 ECTS in total)
- English language skills on a high B2 level proved by a standardised test, see below




High degree of choices:

- Students need to decide about their goals
- Depends on individual pre-knowledge
- Question: Which courses do I want to choose in Summer Semester?
- According to „Prerequisites“ (Module description)
