



Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP)

Good to know!

- Short Term Exchange Format – exchanges last between **5 and 30 days**
- Exchange is conducted in a '**blended**' format: **in-person exchange** is combined with a **digital exchange phase**
- The digital phase takes place **before, during, or after** the in-person programme and is typically used for purposes such as a kick-off, group formation, introduction, or review
- Students and Teachers that travel to the in-person programme receive **financial support** (daily allowance, travel support, green travel and inclusion top-ups) from the Erasmus+ Programme of their home university
- A BIP must include at least **three universities** from three different [EU Member States and third countries associated to the Erasmus+ Programme](#)
- At least **10 student or staff participants** must travel from the participating universities to take part in the in-person programme.
- Students must receive a certificate or Transcript of Records stating that at least **3 ECTS points** have been awarded for taking part in the BIP.
- The **hosting university** receives **financial support** (400 EUR per participant, up to 8000 EUR) for the organisation of the in-person programme of the BIP
