



Erasmus+ Short-Term Exchange

Good to know!

- The latest Erasmus+ programme generation (2021-2027) offers financial support not just for long term but also for **short term staff and student exchanges** (between **5 and 30 days**)
- Condition: exchange is conducted in a '**blended**' format, i.e. **in-person exchange** is combined with a mandatory **digital exchange phase**
- The digital phase takes place **before, during, or after** the in-person programme
- The **digital learning element** is typically used for purposes such as: kick-off, introduction, ice-breaker, group formation, teamwork, or review
- Students and Teachers that travel to the in-person programme receive **financial support** (daily allowance, travel support, top-ups for green travel and students with fewer opportunities) from the Erasmus+ programme of their home university
- Blended exchanges be organised as 1) **Blended Intensive Programmes** (which must include at least three universities participating in Erasmus+ from three different countries) or as 2) **Short-Term Blended Mobilities** (two universities are enough, hosting institution does not have to participate in Erasmus+)
- Erasmus+ short-term blended mobility programmes shall be specifically offered to student groups with restricted access to other types of international mobility
- Students must receive a certificate or Transcript of Records stating that at least **3 ECTS points** have been awarded for taking part in the blended exchange
