Get ready for Berlin: Online German Language Crash Course

Overview

This one-week German pre-course prepares students for a smooth landing in Berlin. They will learn the basics of the language, background information on the city, the country and German culture, as well as which sights not to miss – all before arriving in Berlin and while getting to know their fellow summer school students.

This pre-course can only be selected in combination with a regular summer school programme.

Syllabus

Within seven days of classes, students will develop initial skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing, and gain first knowledge about Berlin and German culture. By the end of the course participants will be able to understand and use everyday expressions and simple phrases aimed at satisfying concrete needs. Students will

- be able to introduce themselves and others and ask others questions about themselves and respond to questions of this type.
- be able to communicate in a simple way if the interlocutor speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to help.
- be able to understand basic oral contributions concerning everyday situations.
- have developed reading strategies to help navigate the university and cityscape and understand simple clues and signage.
- be able to create short texts, e.g. about themselves, about their home region, about intercultural comparisons.

Course delivery

The course will be delivered online on six teaching days with 4 teaching units per day. Of these, 2 will take place as live (synchronous) meetings. For another 2 teaching units, students will receive assignments in Moodle that they can work on asynchronously.

The seventh day (after the arrival in Berlin) is delivered on-site at the HWR Berlin campus.

The course works without a textbook. All course materials are provided in Moodle.
